

MY VOTING PLAN

ELECTION DAY: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5TH

HOW WILL YOU VOTE? (SELECT 1)

- Absentee ballot by mail
- Absentee ballot at my Town Clerk's Office
- Electronic Accessible Absentee Ballot
- At the polls on Election Day!

ARE YOU REGISTERED TO VOTE? (SELECT 1)

- YES- I am registered to vote.
- NO- I will do it by mail before October 15th.
- NO- I will do it online before October 15th.
- NO- I will do it at my Town/City Clerk's Office "in-person" before November 4th.
- NO- I will do it at my polling place on November 5th.

1ST TIME VOTER REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS (SELECT 1)

- Mail-In Voter Registration- Print and complete the Voter Registration Card. Make copies of your identity and residency documents. Mail the card and photocopied documents to your Town/City Clerk.
- Online Voter Registration- Go to the Secretary of State's Website and follow the instructions for online voter registration.
- In-Person Voter Registration- Bring your ID and residency verification document to your Town/City Clerk's Office. Follow the staff member's instructions to complete your voter registration card.
- Election Day Voter Registration- Bring your ID and residency verification document to your polling location. tell the poll workers you need to register to vote. Follow their instructions.

WHERE MIGHT I NEED SUPPORT?

ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL

CHECK OFF ALL ACTIONS WHERE YOU MIGHT NEED SUPPORT.

Requesting my absentee ballot from my Town/City Clerk.

Retrieving my ballot from my mailbox.

Reading my ballot.

Marking my ballot.

Returning my completed ballot back to my Town/City Clerk. (Your ballot can be mailed, hand delivered to Town/City Clerk's Office, or placed in a ballot drop box if your town has one!)

CHECK OFF ALL ACTIONS WHERE YOU MIGHT NEED SUPPORT.

Picking a time to go to my Town/City Clerk's Office.

Locating my Town/City Hall.

Getting transportation to my Town/City Clerk's Office.

Finding the Clerk's Office in the Town/City Hall Building.

Asking for an absentee ballot in the office.

Reading my ballot.

Marking my ballot.

ELECTRONIC ACCESSIBLE ABSENTEE BALLOT

CHECK OFF ALL ACTIONS WHERE YOU MIGHT NEED SUPPORT.

Requesting my ballot from the Secretary of State's Website.

Accessing my ballot through my email account.

Completing my ballot and submitting it.

CHECK OFF ALL ACTIONS WHERE YOU MIGHT NEED SUPPORT.

Locating my polling place and the hours it's open.

Getting transportation to and from the polling place.

Getting inside of my polling place.

Telling the poll workers my name and address at check-in.

Asking to use the Accessible Voting System.

Reading my ballot.

Marking my ballot.

Placing my completed ballot in the scanner machine.

IMPORTANT DATES

August 5th: Absentee ballots can be requested

October 5th: Absentee ballots will be mailed by Town/City Clerks.

October 15th: DEADLINE to register to vote by mail and online.
After this date you can register to vote at your Town/City Office OR at the polls on Election Day.

October 31st at 5:00pm: DEADLINE to request an absentee ballot

November 5th: ELECTION DAY

November 5th at 8:00pm: DEADLINE- absentee ballots must be received at your Town/City Clerk's Office
