A step-by-step instruction would be too cumbersome, given that everybody uses different hardware and software in their daily lives. But somebody familiar with your platform can guide you through these generic instructions.

Don't list every conceivable location on the cheat sheet, because it should be a single page with a readable sized font.

1. Use a word processor to set up two columns.

2. Utilizing the strategy followed in the example above, for each deck of the ship, using deck plans available on the Internet (Google: *name of ship* deck plans), list the pertinent venues for each deck, in an order roughly from front of ship to rear of ship, Type the appropriate abbreviation F, M, or A to the right of the item name to indicate Fore, Mid, or Aft. To make it even quicker and easier to use, color all the F items the same, all the M items the same, and all the A items the same.
3. Create a PDF or other image file with almost no margins.
4. Transfer that image to a smart phone.
5. Make that image a clickable icon on the phone's home page.

Then, the critical part — make use of this guide on the ship, especially during the first few days. It can save you so much wasted time, human energy, or battery energy, or all the above!
